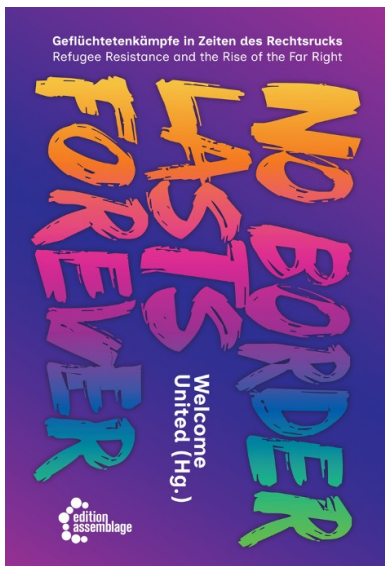

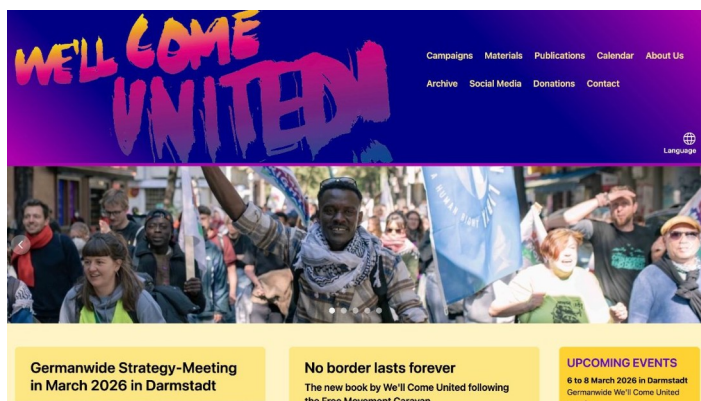


A coordination and strategy meeting, a decentralised action calendar currently in planning, a newly revised website and, last but not least, a new book: We'll Come United, the germanwide network of groups and initiatives for freedom of movement and equal rights, will be active on several levels simultaneously in March 2026 – the counter-programme to ongoing racist agitation and new laws of exclusion.

Six months after the Free Movement Caravan in September 2025, the new publication will be presented for the first time at the Leipzig Book Fair: 'No border lasts forever – Refugee Resistance and the Rise of the Far Right'. The book from We'll Come

United is a powerful testament to resilience, solidarity, and the fight for human rights. The introduction states: „...Over the years, our struggles have become more connected across borders, less spontaneous perhaps, but more conscious and rooted in shared experience. This book is a contribution to documenting those times of resistance and solidarity, not from above, but from within the struggles themselves. It focuses on self-organized resistance, on transnational solidarity networks, and on concrete fights against criminalization, border violence, and detention regimes across Europe and along the migration routes...”

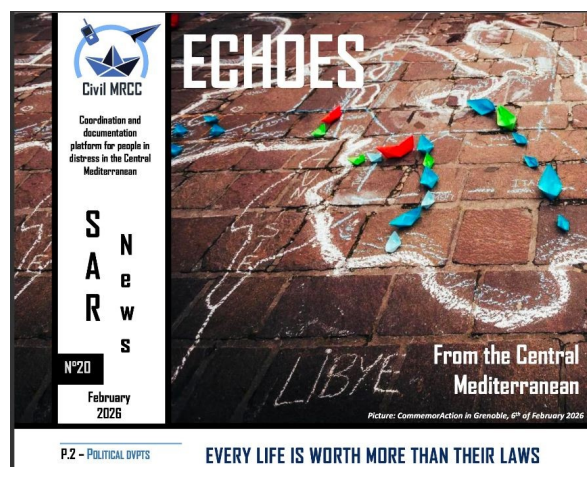
The book from We'll Come United is to be presented in as many cities as possible in the coming months, ideally in combination with proposals for regional actions. So far, plans include a demonstration at Frankfurt's deportation airport at the end of May, participation in 'widersetzen' (against the racist party AfD) in Erfurt in July, and a new caravan in Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania at the end of August. Hopefully, other groups will develop their own ideas in many other places. The book is thus intended to amplify anti-racist campaigns and establish connections with transnational struggles beyond the external borders and the Mediterranean.



Keyword: external borders. One year before the elections in Italy, the post-fascist Meloni government is once again playing the racist card, as was to be expected. Under the guise of new so-called security laws and in the wake of the CEAS(pact)-implementation in June 2026, it is seeking to

escalate the criminalisation of migration and the repression of civilian sea rescue operations. A 'naval blockade' is in preparation, a new version of Salvini's port closures, to prevent the arrival of refugees and migrants by force.

There is no question that these state 'border crimes' will continue to meet with stubborn resistance under the new conditions. On a practical level, this resistance will continue in



the form of the Civil Fleet, as impressively documented once again in the diary of the new edition of the publication 'Echoes'. But it will also continue on a legal level, where Sea Watch recently achieved a more than symbolic double victory. In the 2019 case concerning Salvini's unlawful detention of the Sea Watch with Carola Rackete, the Italian government must now pay damages of 76,000 euros. At the same time, the

Italian administration's current order to detain the new Sea Watch 5 for refusing to communicate with Libyan militias was immediately overturned by a court.

With this in mind: „From the Sea to the Cities“ – solidarity in the fight for freedom of movement and equal rights will continue at all levels in spring 2026.

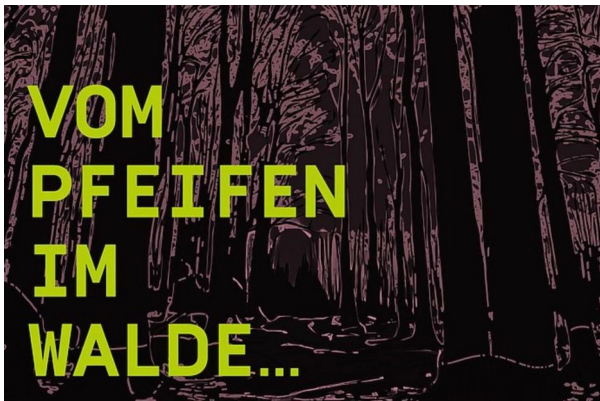

16 TO 23 MARCH IN SEVERAL CITIES: MEDICO EVENTS WITH FILM & DISCUSSION ON THE POLISH-BELARUSIAN BORDER IN MUNICH (16 MARCH), TÜBINGEN (17 MARCH), MANNHEIM (18 MARCH), FRANKFURT (19 MARCH), HANOVER (20 MARCH) AND BERLIN (22 MARCH)

"Europe is closing its doors to refugees. And Poland is following suit. The wall that the Polish government has erected on the border with Belarus in recent years is almost 200 kilometres long and more than five metres high, studded with barbed wire and monitored by thousands of soldiers and border guards. It is intended to prevent refugees from coming to Europe. Those who do manage to get through are pushed back, chased through the forest and beaten. They can no longer apply for asylum since the so-



called Citizens' Coalition under Prime Minister Donald Tusk suspended the right to asylum in March 2025. This is a clear violation of European law, but the EU has not criticised it. Despite all this, there are still people in the border area who show solidarity and assist refugees on their dangerous journey. The Polish state is trying to break this support through

prosecutions and repression. To discuss the situation on the ground, we at medico international are inviting our cooperation partners to Germany: two activists from the Szpila collective. They support people who are affected by state repression because they have helped refugees in the Polish-Belarusian border area.

The documentary film 'Forest' will be shown at the beginning. It follows Asia, Marek and their three children, who live in their own paradise: their house is located in the middle of Europe's last primeval forests, almost on the outer borders of the EU. During their daily forays into the forest, one day they find more than just breathtaking images of

bison, moose and badgers on their wildlife cameras. Instead, they encounter hungry, hypothermic and often sick people moving through the thicket – fleeing to the EU. The Polish family decides to help and is almost broken by the fates unfolding right on their doorstep.

On 19 March 2026, six month after the Free Movement Caravan in September 2025, We'll Come United's new book will be presented for the first time at the Leipzig Book Fair: „No border lasts forever – Refugee Resistance and the Rise of the Far Right“. At the same evening we invite in Leipzig to another presentation and discussion about experiences and perspectives of We`ll Come United.

The book is a collection of texts, speeches and photos in German and English. From the announcement: „Europe is turning right, and refugees are being cast as enemies. Yet across Germany, Europe, and African transit routes, they are resisting – fighting for their rights, dignity, and freedom of movement. From billions spent on border fortifications and racist laws to deals with authoritarian regimes, European politics seeks to block or deport those on the move. But refugees are organizing, forming transnational networks like We`ll Come United to oppose isolation, violence, and injustice. This book tells the story of their struggle: from EU-funded abuse in Libya to night-time deportations from German 'Dublin-centers', from the first movements in the 1990s to today's new anti-racist alliances across Europe and beyond the Mediterranean. A powerful testament to resilience, solidarity, and the fight for human rights.“

In view of state repression and an authoritarian turn in Europe and many other countries around the world, we invite activists and academics to join us in discussing analyses of the current situation, strategies of resistance and possible political interventions.

In the tradition of 'scientific anti-fascism,' the conference combines analyses of labour exploitation and border externalisation with conceptual-theoretical debates and possibilities for political intervention, as well as the reappraisal of anti-racist knowledge archives from previous struggles. Call for solidarity with El Hiblu 3

Saturday, 28 March 2026 in Valletta, Malta

09:00 to 16:00 CET, in a public place still to be announced

Join us for a seven-hour vigil with a press conference, speeches, street-theatre, music, info-table, banners and more to protest against seven years of ongoing criminalization against three human rights defenders.

On 28th of March 2019 Abdalla, Amara and Kader arrived in Malta, having been rescued from a sinking rubber boat in the middle of the Mediterranean Sea. At just 15, 16 and 19 years old, their dream of arriving in Europe had come to pass, yet a new nightmare was just beginning.

On 28th of March 2026, it will be 2,555 days since the El Hiblu 3 arrived in Malta and since they have been criminalised, unjustly accused of having committed multiple crimes, including acts of terrorism, threatening a crew, and hijacking a ship, charges that could carry life sentences.

With this protest, we will continue to show our solidarity with the three young men, whom we awarded a human rights defenders prize for the bravery they showed as mediators and translators when facing the threat of an illegal pushback to Libya.

During our seven-hour vigil, we will condemn the ongoing injustice against the El Hiblu 3 and mark every hour, and thus every year, with a different activity focused on:

- Criminalization of refugees and migrants arriving in Europe;
- Illegal push backs, particularly in the Central Mediterranean;
- EU externalization policies with a particular view on the deals with Libya and Tunisia;
- Increasing deportations from Malta and other EU countries;
- Campaigns against racism and social exclusion in Malta;
- The civil fleet and its work against a politics of abandonment and pushbacks;
- Transnational networking and resistance against the EU border regime.

Please save the date and contact us if you are interested in joining us and if you have additional ideas for the seven-hour protest. We will spread and publish a more detailed program in early March on our website.

ECHOES NR. 20 - "EVERY LIFE IS WORTH MORE THAN THEIR LAWS!"

IT MAKES A DIFFERENCE!

A DIARY OF RESCUE COORDINATION BY CIVIL ACTORS IN THE CENTRAL MEDITERRANEAN SEA

The following section provides an overview of the level and impact of rescue coordination by civil actors in the Central Mediterranean Sea, using brief reports and social media extracts.

NOVEMBER 2025

- November 1 **Trottamar III** rescued 16 people from a rubber boat. Survivors were disembarked in Lampedusa.
- November 2 **Mare Jonio** rescued 37 people who were on an overcrowded fiberglass vessel at risk of sinking in international waters in a Libyan-controlled SAR zone. They had been at sea for three days without drinking water or food. After this rescue, **Mare Jonio** rescued another 28 people from a rubber boat off the coast of Lampedusa. A third and final rescue occurred the following morning of 27 people from a fiberglass boat. Survivors of all three rescues were disembarked in Porto Empedocle.
- November 3 After an alert by **Alarm Phone**, **Aurora** rescued 35 people from a rubber dinghy. Survivors were disembarked in Lampedusa.
- November 5 **Seabird 1** spotted a rubber boat with 71 people and alerted authorities. **Nadir** was able to respond and rescue the people, bringing them to Lampedusa.
- November 6 In the morning, 53 people became trapped on the supply vessel **MANIDVE**. **Seabird 1** was on scene and alerted relevant authorities, who ignored calls and refused help. **Trottamar III** was nearby and could render assistance after more than 48 hours of failed attempts to coordinate with state actors. Survivors were brought to Lampedusa, several were in poor medical condition after days stranded at sea.

„On the 6th of February 2026, decentralized CommemorActions took place in over 60 cities across the Mediterranean sea. The gatherings collectively remembered the massacre which took place 12 years ago in Tarajal near Ceuta. Alongside relatives of the dead and missing at the borders, families and friends of victims of state and police violence

within Europe joined this growing network of solidarity. The planned implementation of the racist CEAS pact and the brutalized externalization policies threaten to bring even more suffering and death in the near future. This is why we must unite transnationally in the struggle for justice, equal rights, and freedom of movement, placing the testimonies and demands of relatives at the heart of our collective action!...“

VIOLENT ATTACKS DO NOT STOP BOATS FROM CROSSING THE CENTRAL MED!

Alarm Phone: Central Mediterranean Analysis, 1 July to 31 December 2025

„In the second half of 2025, Alarm Phone was alerted to 428 boats in distress in the central Mediterranean Sea. In the prior six months, January to June 2025, we had been alerted to 334 boats on this migration route, which means that over the whole year of 2025, a total number of 762 boats reached out to us from this region. According to data by the UNHCR, arrivals to Italy via Libya and Tunisia stood at about 66,200 people at the end of 2025, which is nearly identical to 2024. The vast majority of boats departed from Libya.

The IOM has estimated that 1,314 have died over 2025 in this central Mediterranean region. We should emphasise, however, that any statistical count of deaths and disappearances can only ever be considered as rough estimates, which need to be treated with caution. Many deaths or disappearances are never documented and so we can expect a higher death toll.



The civil fleet has continued to carry out rescues and remains resilient, despite the ongoing assault on their solidarity at sea. Alarm Phone is a member the Civil Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre. According to them, ca. 280 boats were rescued or assisted by the civil fleet in 2025.

Over the past six months, we have witnessed time and again that boats of people on the move and those of the civil rescue fleet were attacked by Libyan forces and militias. We have also witnessed repeated pushbacks (by proxy) of boats from within the Maltese Search and Rescue zone, something that the documentation of the Malta Migration Archive has also confirmed. In this analysis, we provide a comprehensive chronology of the second half of 2025, offering in great detail an account of developments as they unfolded in the central Mediterranean Sea. As nobody else is doing so, we need to create our own archive of migrant struggles and acts of solidarity.

We will continue in our struggle alongside people on the move and document the border violence that they face. In our daily practice, we struggle against borders, for ferries, not Frontex, and the freedom of movement for all..."

SEA WATCH: SUCCESSES IN COURT

Defeat for the interior minister: Italian government must pay €76,000 in damages to Sea-Watch

Palermo / Rome / Berlin – Within a few days, two landmark rulings have confirmed the course of civilian sea rescue and put the far-right Italian government in its place. The government is currently planning to revive its 2018 policy of closed ports. It was this very policy that Carola Rackete rebelled against in 2019 and for which Italy has just been ordered to pay a substantial amount in damages.

Last week, the civil court in Palermo ordered the Italian government to pay Sea-Watch €76,000 in damages. The background to this was the illegal refusal of the prefecture of Agrigento in 2019 to lift a six-month seizure of the Sea-Watch 3.

The seizure took place in the context of the so-called security decrees of the then Interior Minister Matteo Salvini. The case gained international attention in particular after Sea-Watch captain Carola Rackete entered the port of Lampedusa in June 2019

with 53 rescued people. Rackete was briefly arrested, but several courts confirmed the legality of her disobedience in the following years.

Salvini is now Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Transport in Giorgia Meloni's government. Interior Minister Matteo Piantedosi, who was already involved in the security decrees in 2018, is currently preparing new measures, a so-called "naval

blockade," which would allow for far-reaching entry bans for rescue ships.

According to the drafts known so far, Italian authorities could in future deny ships with rescued people on board entry into Italian territorial waters for up to six months. In addition,

heavy fines and possible confiscation are envisaged for non-cooperation.

"We thank Matteo and Matteo and are already considering how we can use the financial injection from the Ministry of the Interior as effectively as possible against the current and future policies of the two," says Bana Mahmood, press spokesperson for Sea-Watch. "We hope that this ruling will also serve as a lesson to the current government. What failed in 2019 will also fail in 2026 – Italy's functioning, democratic justice system will see to that."

Yesterday, Wednesday, the civil court in Catania accordingly lifted the official ban on the Sea-Watch 5 rescue ship leaving port. The ship had been detained by the regional representative of the Italian Ministry of the Interior after rescuing 18 people in international waters off the Libyan coast. The crew of the rescue ship had refused to inform Libyan militias about their ongoing rescue operation.

Sea-Watch, together with 12 other sea rescue organizations, had joined forces in early November 2025 to form the Justice Fleet alliance and announced that it would cease operational communication with the so-called Libyan coast guard, which has been proven to commit serious abuses and illegal interceptions against those seeking protection."

DEPORTATION FIGURES IN GERMANY IN 2025

"The Federal Government has published its response to a minor interpellation by The Left Party in the Bundestag on deportations in 2025:

The total number of deportations rose to 22,787, which is slightly more than in the previous year (20,084) (and is roughly at the pre-coronavirus level).

Of these, 5,377 were transfers under the Dublin Regulation.

However, there was a very sharp increase in the number of deportations to certain countries.

This applies in particular to Greece, although there were only 26 Dublin transfers to that country, i.e. most of the deportations were due to third-country procedures.

But the number of deportations also rose sharply to Iraq, where there had been virtually no deportations for decades, and especially to Turkey.

One in six (!) people deported from Germany last year were minors.

A total of 3,628 children and young people were deported from Germany – usually together with their parents.

1,593 deportations failed after handover to the federal police (i.e. at the airport), 510 of them due to the refusal of the flight captain, and even 4 due to the refusal of the ship's captain (in the case of transfer by sea)..."

COMMEMORATIONS 6. FEBRUAR 2026



„On 6 February, families, friends, and solidarity groups gathered to mark the World Day of Commemoration and Action, honouring people who have died or disappeared due to state violence along migration routes and within local communities.

The date recalls the events of 6 February 2014, when more than 200 people attempted to reach Tarajal beach in Ceuta from the Moroccan coast. Spanish Guardia Civil officers used anti-riot equipment to stop them from reaching shore while Moroccan forces looked on. Fifteen bodies were recovered on the Spanish side, dozens more disappeared, and survivors



were returned, with additional deaths reported on the Moroccan side. CommemorActions combine remembrance and protest, supporting families seeking truth, justice, and recognition for their loved ones. Each year, events are held worldwide to denounce deaths, disappearances, and trauma linked to migration policies and state violence...."

This year, we gathered on 14 February in our new premises at Krämerstraße 24 in Hanau and, on 19 February, despite the cold and bad weather, we were once again on the streets with many people. The fact that so many of you were there shows that remembrance is stronger than silence, stronger than forgetting...".
